The Form must be submitted to the Bishop before fixing a date for the marriage. It must be submitted together with the Pre-Nuptial Inquiry duly filled. Also, the application for permission/ dispensation for Mixed Marriage or dispensation for Disparity of Cult where applicable. One must not assume that Dispensation will be granted upon Application.

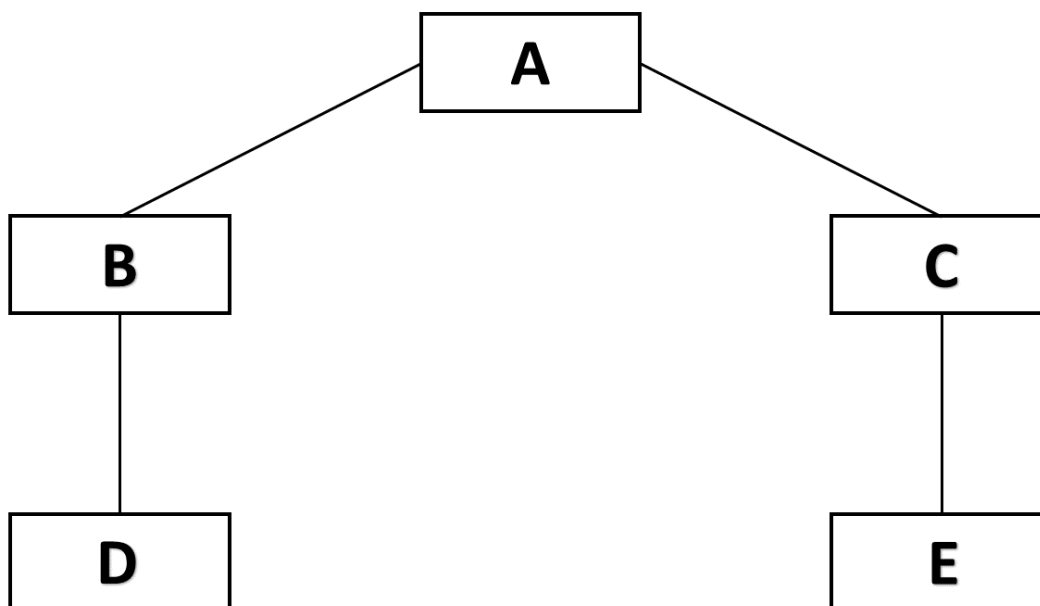
